### Lady Jackets 8th Place Team Finish is Highest Ever at NAIA Nationals

The women's track and field team truly had a team effort as 8 Lady Jacket track & field performers competing in 11 events scored 35.5 points to finish 8th in the NAIA National Championships. This was the team's highest ever finish at this event. This effort had 6 competitors scoring in 6 different events. (see side bar)

The championship started well for the women as Michalina Gluchowski threw well in the hammer and finished 8th scoring the first team point. The 10,000 meter run was our next scoring event that found Jen Tetric battling it out with the leaders. Jen ran an incredibly smart race and PR'd by 18 seconds to finish 4th in an outstanding field.

Next on the track was Erin Nehus in the 3K. Erin ran a great race and at about the 1200

meter mark took the lead that she would not surrender until about 200 meters to go when she was passed with a furious kick. Erin followed with her own kick as she raced in to finish a very strong 2nd.

Rachael Castro was up next in the PV. She was competing well at the lower heights but then had two misses at 11-6 before she had a great effort to clear that height. She then cleared 11-11-3/4 on her first attempt as the large Cedarville cheering section went wild. The competition was now down to two. Both jumpers missed 3 attempts at 12-6. Rachael had 1 more miss so she finished 2nd even though both girls cleared the same height.

Kate Beatty was now up in the HJ. She has had an outstanding season clearing 5-6 in

almost every outdoor meet. Kate jumped well in clearing 5-4 and finished her career with a 7th place finish.

The last individual event of the day was the 5K. Erin Nehus and Sarah Roberts led the way as both were in a tight pack of four all racing for 2nd place as the leader was way out in front. Erin again found herself in a great race for the finish. With 200 meters to go, Erin and another competitor switched position several times before Erin took the lead for good with 40 meters to go. Sarah ran an excellent race and finished 5th.



### Men's Team Led by Standout Sergio Reyes

The men's team brought 7 competitors competing in 10 different events. Many good performances were achieved by this group but only Sergio Reyes finished in the top 8.

The men started the meet with a discouraging event as 5th ranked decathlete senior Mike Marsh had a pulled hamstring and was not able to compete at his normal level. He showed the true meaning of competition by having an upbeat attitude and doing his best.

Sergio Reyes is recognized as

one of the top distance runners in the NAIA and he showed this to be a legitimate title once again. He was in a fierce competition with 2 other competitors in the 10k as they battled the entire race. With about 600 meters to go Sergio pulled ahead and convincingly won. In the 5k it was a similar type of race as the competitors switched positions often before the final 300 meter kick as all the runners went all out. Sergio ran a great race and finished a strong 3rd to earn his second All-American honor of the champion-

ship.
